# Climbing Ramp

- 1) Refer to your play system Owner's Manual** for important information on Choosing a Safe Installation Site, Installation Tips, and Maintenance and Safe Use. If you do not have your manual, call ChildLife at (800) 467-9464 to request a free replacement.
- 2) Read these instructions thoroughly before you begin** to ensure an easy and safe installation.
- 3) Inventory the parts.** The Climbing Ramp comes in one box marked #51. Refer to the Box Packing List on the reverse of this page.
- 4) Install the two hooks at the top of the Climbing Ramp.** See Illustration 1. Locate the two Mounting Hooks in the hardware bag. Install them as shown in the pre-drilled holes using the four 1-1/2" #12 Pan Head Screws and a Phillips Head Screwdriver. Use a slow, careful motion to ensure that the screws follow the pre-drilled holes and are well seated. When finished, the head of the screws must be snug against the Mounting Hooks, which must be seated firmly against the Climbing Ramp for maximum security.
- 5) Fasten the Climbing Ramp Rope.** See Illustration 1. Insert either end of the rope into the hole at the top of Climbing Ramp. Tie one overhand knot leaving a 3" "tail" after knot is tied. Repeat at bottom of Climbing Ramp. Pull on rope to tighten knot.
- 6) Attach the Climbing Ramp to your play system.** See Illustration 2. Using the Mounting Hooks, "hook" the Climbing Ramp on to the desired rung about 4' off the ground. Do not select a rung more than 4' off the ground. Pull the bottom out from under the Climbing Ramp to ensure that the Mounting Hooks are secure on the rung.
- 7) Open the plastic bag containing the Hand Grips.** Install as instructed.
