INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

1) Refer to the Assembly Instructions and Owner's Manual of your play system for important information on Choosing a Safe Installation Site and Installation Tips, including guidance on using ChildLife's recessed Safety Nuts. Also, read the important sections on Maintenance and Safe Use. If you do not have your manual, call ChildLife at (800) 467-9464 to request a free replacement.

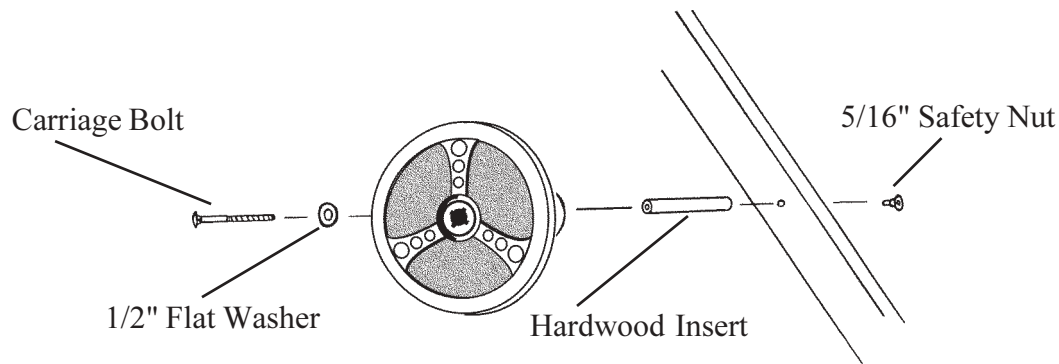
2) Read these instructions thoroughly before you begin. This will help ensure an easy and safe installation. Be sure to read the paragraph called "**Prepare the Steering Wheel for Installation**" at the top of the reverse side of this page.

If you are attaching the Steering Wheel to:

- a **Dashboard**, go to Step 3 - Use a 6-1/2" Carriage Bolt
- a **Crow's Nest Treehouse**, go to Step 4 - Use a 4-1/2" Carriage Bolt
- a **Firechief's Treehouse**, go to Step 5 - Use a 4-1/2" Carriage Bolt
- a **Sandcastle**, go to the Sandcastle Instructions - Use a 4-1/2" Carriage Bolt

Installation Instructions are continued on the reverse of this page. If the reverse is blank, call ChildLife for a free replacement copy.

Prepare the Steering Wheel for Installation. See the illustration below. Use the bolt length indicated for your application. Slide the washer on to the bolt. Push the Hardwood Insert completely into the hole in the center of the Steering Wheel (sometimes it is easier to push it through the front, rather than through the back). Note that the bolt (with washer already in place) travels first through the Steering Wheel and the Hardwood Insert, and then through the horizontal hole at the installation point. Use the 5/16" Safety Nut and Hex Key Wrench to **fasten securely**.



3) Attach the Steering Wheel to the Dashboard. Use a 6-1/2" Carriage Bolt and the pre-drilled horizontal hole in the center of the Dashboard top. Steering Wheel must face **IN** to play system.

4) Attach the Steering Wheel to a Crow's Nest Treehouse. Use a 4-1/2" Carriage Bolt and a pre-drilled horizontal hole about 12" in from the end of the horizontal rail opposite the trap door. Steering Wheel must face **IN** to Crow's Nest. If your Crow's Nest was manufactured before 1998, drill this hole yourself using a household drill and 1/2" drill bit.

5) Attach the Steering Wheel to a Firechief's Treehouse. Use a 4-1/2" Carriage Bolt and the pre-drilled horizontal hole about 24" in from the **Knotted Rope end** of the 68" Pole/Rope Top Crossarm. Steering Wheel **must** face **in** to Firechief's Treehouse. If your play system was manufactured before 1998, drill this hole yourself using a household drill and 1/2" drill bit.

6) Follow these instructions for Safe Use. The Steering Wheel should never be mounted more than 3' above the surfacing or the platform. It must always face **in** to play system. The Steering Wheel is not meant to be climbed on or used as a support, for hands or feet, in the climbing process.
