- 1) Pencil
- 2) Electric Drill w/ 1/8" Drill Bit
- 3) Large Phillips Head Screwdriver

BOX PACKING LIST

BOX 50 - HAND GRIPS (PAIR)

Step 1 - Selecting the Location of the Hand Grips

Decide where to mount the Hand Grips. Common locations are on the 2" x 4" uprights at spots where children are climbing on to platforms or into treehouses. Center the Grip in the middle of the location you have selected, and use a pencil to mark the exact location of the holes. Telephone ChildLife toll-free if you have questions.

Step 2 - Drilling the Holes

Drill holes 1/2" deep into the uprights at the marked holes. To avoid drilling too deeply, wrap masking tape around your drill bit leaving only 1/2" exposed.

Step 3 - Attaching Hand Grips

Slip the washers provided on to the pan head screws. Position the Hand Grips over the pilot holes and use the screwdriver to install the screws. Use a slow, careful motion to ensure that the screws follow the pilot holes and are well seated. When finished, the head of the screw should be snug against the washer and Hand Grip. The Hand Grip must be seated firmly against the play system for maximum security.
