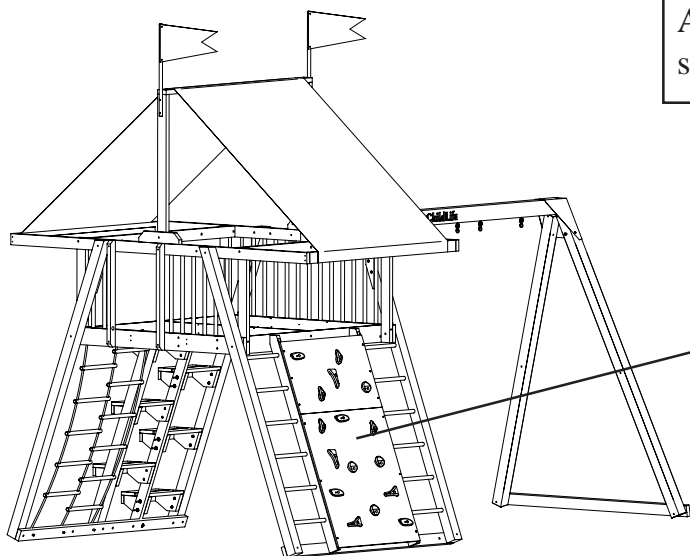


Cascade Alpine Climber

The Cascade Alpine Climber is an add-on to your ChildLife play system. These assembly instructions must be used in conjunction with the Assembly Instructions and Owner's Manual of the play system you have purchased.

Please be sure you read and understand our recommendations for safe installation sites and safety during installation, as well as the US Consumer Products Safety Commission's recommendations concerning the depth of various resilient surfacing materials. Mounting your Cascade Alpine Climber (refer to the Figure)

1. Unpack the Cascade Alpine Climber components (refer to the parts list below).
2. Attach each Rock set (4) to the climber assemblies (2 & 3) using cap screws (5) and No. 10 x 3/4" screws (7).
3. Choose an open accessory location to mount the climber.
4. Position the climber bottom assembly (larger section for 5.5' deck height) (2) on the ladder supports or uprights. The edges must be parallel to the ladder supports or uprights, and evenly positioned. The bottom edge of the bottom assembly must be approximately one-inch above the ends of the ladder supports or uprights.
5. Attach the climber bottom assembly (2) to the ladder supports using three wood screws (6) in each edge.
6. Place the climber top assembly (smaller section for 5.5' deck height) (3) on the top edge of the climber bottom assembly (2) so it is even with the edges of the bottom assembly.
7. Attach the climber top assembly (3) to the ladder supports using three wood screws (6) in each edge.
8. Locate one hole in the top rail and one hole in the bottom stringer that are centered on the rock wall. Insert the climbing rope (1) through the top rail and the bottom stringer. Install the rope tight enough that it cannot form a loop. Tie a single knot in each end of the rope on the back side of the top rail and stringer.
Rope should be tight enough so it cannot form a loop.
